Scouts Air Activities Victoria

VSA have been negotiating with Scouts Air Activities Victoria for them to have gliding as part of their air experiences and badge requirements for 11-15 year old Scouts/Cubs.

To this end, during the month of April, "Try Gliding 2019" has been initiated and will be advertised and promoted on the Scouts Air Activities Victoria website and which we are co-hosting on the <u>VSA</u> <u>Facebook</u> page.

The Program:

In essence, the Scout Leaders in your regions will contact your club directly via the directory information on the VSA website to arrange a Scouts gliding day, and as per your normal booking practice, you provide the details of your operation and co-ordinate a day with them that suits you both. If you are unable to assist, please refer them to another club with contact details that is close to your region.

To make it affordable for the them and to kick start the campaign, please consider what is the best discount you can provide for a 1500 ft flight as a minimum. Obviously, winch clubs will do very well!!

To give an example, the programs they have for fixed wing flying at Moorabbin Airport are subsidized by the operators who provide 20 mins flights for \$60.

Due the GFA levy, if you want to provide "hands-on" instruction, this will need to be factored into your flight costs. Your club may like to consider subsidizing also.

These are young people, specifically interested in aviation, and they only do these programs once or twice a year. They must do well to complete their badge criteria.

They provide an opportunity for our continued future as a sport and introduce more young people to gliding.

Addendum

Bacchus Marsh are ahead of the game! On Monday afternoon, 4th March, 20 Cubs and their supporters attended Bacchus Marsh airfield. They were given an explanation of aeroplanes, gliders and how they fly. They were shown the Slingsby T31, Duo Discus modern 2 seater and also visited the Australian Gliding Museum. The Cubs responded very enthusiastically and Dave Goldsmith is keen to arrange more of these visits. A fourteen-year-old (older brother of a cub) expressed interest in commencing gliding. A local Scouts leader who was present is arranging a similar visit for his Scout group. All three clubs were represented and no particular club was favoured during the visit.

ASC Club Health Check

The Australian Sports Commission has produced The Club Health Check which is an online selfassessment tool aimed at helping clubs examine how they are operating. The checklist looks at a
number of different factors that are crucial to success at club level and together these factors are used
to build an overall picture of the way your club carries out its operations.

The last assessment was completed in 2013. The assessment should take no more than 30 minutes to complete. Once you have answered all questions, a detailed report will be emailed to you which will identify improvements and growth areas for your club.

It is recommended that the assessment be completed together by 2 or 3 people from your committee and preferably "key" people who have an overall perspective of the operations and activities of the club. Please contact your VSA Committee Buddy Club member to assist.

Succession Planning – Why?

Succession planning can be an important way to identify club members who have the current skills--or the potential to develop skills--that can help them participate in a club or association. A succession plan, in particular, leaves your club or association prepared to replace senior people. In addition, the process of succession planning can help to identify other areas where club or association volunteers can invest in training which could help to manage and improve your club or association.

Effective succession planning activities have a positive impact in terms of ensuring that key positions will remain filled with competent performers.

To this end, a Succession Planning template is available on the <u>VSA Website / Documents / Reference</u>.




Premier's Active April

Is your club participating in your region? So far once club has signed up. It doesn't take much. Go to Premier's Active April, select MyLocal and add an event. All it needs is a bit of blurb, select 1/4/2019 - 30/4/ 2019, (bit hard in gliding to select just one day due to weather, unless you want to make it an Open Day) provide a discounted price for a flight, a photo and submit. See the screenshots below on what you will see to sign up.

The PAA team will approve and load your content.

Registrants (general public) who want to do the "Try It, Fly It" flight have to register to get a PAA Pass which they must advise to you when booking a flight with you and present the pass to you on the day to receive the discount flight.
