FLARM uses a rolling release cycle, requiring an annual update. Each update can be applied anytime during a rolling one-year period.

As the update cycle is individual, no generic information is sent out on individual firmware expiration dates. There is a FLARM news sign-up that can help users stay up to date with upcoming releases.
