Invitation to Horsham Coaching Week 2022

John Orton will be co-ordinating the Horsham Coaching Week in early 2022. It will be held at the Horsham Airfield from 29th January until 4th February 2022.

The week is primarily to foster post solo glider pilots and to enhance their cross-country gliding techniques. The level is pitched at solo pilots who wish to extend their soaring

abilities across the fence. There will lectures or seminars be and weather briefings held in the mornings with flying in the afternoons. Coaching will be available in two x 2 seaters and single seat gliders are welcome. Many pilots turn up and participate in private gliders or hire a club glider. Attempts to fly FAI badge flights will be encouraged.



John is an Official Observer and will be available on site to verify the claims.

There will be several high performance two seat gliders available with coaches if you feel that you will benefit from a two-seater coaching flight.

So, with the Australian Junior Gliding Club's Victorian Local Series Regatta and Coaching Week in place of Joeyglide, the Horsham Coaching Week and Horsham Week competition and the VSA State Gliding Championships in Benalla in March, it turned out to be a good gliding season.
