## YOUTHGLIDE SCHOLARSHIPS ARE NOW OPEN!!

The VSA is sending this information to you directly as circulation, in some instances, has not occurred through club channels.

In line with our mission, the Victorian Soaring Association (VSA) is offering scholarships to encourage young people to continue their gliding journey, whether it is working towards GPC, gaining cross country badges and records or working towards being a competition pilot.

The attainment of a scholarship also looks good on the resume if you are seeking a pathway to a career in aviation!

Applications are **NOW OPEN** for the 2023 VSA YouthGlide Gliding Scholarships, for the period 1 July 2023 to 30 June 2024 via the [YouthGlide Scholarships](#) link.

The scholarships will be open to applicants who have reached the age of 15 years by 1 July, 2023 and who will be no older than 26 years by 30th June, 2024.

This year, six (6) scholarships will be available and are open to both male and female pilots. Scholarships will only be awarded if the applicants fulfill the current VSA Gliding Vic/Tas YouthGlide scholarship criteria already in place.

The allocation of the scholarships are:

- 1 x President's scholarship valued at \$1500, and
- 5 x general scholarships valued at \$1000 each

The scholarship does not include Gliding Federation of Australia or Club membership costs.
